Badges and honorary pins used by Deutscher Dan-Trager und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V.

Abstract

The Deutscher Dan-Trager und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V. (DDBV e.V.) was founded in 1979 and uses two different kinds of fabric badges to be applied to Karate or Jiu-Jitsu Gis. The standard badge can be worn by all members of the association, while the "*Budo* Lehrer" (*Budo* Teacher) badge is reserved for members of the association who have acquired the certificate as a "DDBV Budo-Lehrer". In addition, there are badges of honour issued by the DDBV e.V. to long-term members and for extraordinary accomplishments fostering the statutory objectives of the association.

The logo of the Deutscher Dan-Traeger und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V.

The logo of the DDBV e.V. is composed of diverse symbols, which have been consciously chosen by the executive committee during design phase. The logo shows a snake, which is wound around a Japanese sword. On the sword's handle there is a paragraph symbol, which, however, is depicted in a mirrored way. The colours used in the logo are black (writing and outlines), golden (the snake) and red (background).

The sword represents all martial arts, the snake stands for medical science, the flexibility and velocity of techniques applied in martial arts. The mirrored paragraph symbol stands for the justice system, representing one of the key objectives of the DDBV e.V. to stand against illegal practices especially regarding excrescences with respect to Dan graduations. It is mirrored, symbolising the discrepancy between being right and being granted right. The colours are matching the ones of the German flag.

The logo has been designed namely by the founder, former chairman and today's Honorary President of the *Deutscher Dan-Traeger und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V.*, Lothar Sieber and elaborated by the member Prof. Dr. mult. Sven Hooge.

The fabric badges of the Deutscher Dan-Trager und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V.

There are two different kinds of fabric badges used by the DDBV e.V.:

- The standard badge, which every member receives when acquiring membership
- The "DDBV Budo-Lehrer" badge. Members who are eligible to wear it are who have passed the official examinations and graduated with the special degree of the "DDBV Budo-Lehrer" (DDBV certified Budo Teacher).





The "DDBV Budo-Lehrer" degree is issued to members, who have attended a defined curriculum teaching diverse subjects. A qualified Budo Teacher is expected to have

appropriate knowledge of (medical science, law, history, philosophy, didactics and methodology of teaching martial arts and others).

There were about 500 standard fabric badges issued over the past 39 years since the DDBV's foundation. Up to now 32 members were awarded the "DDBV Budo Lehrer", partly using multiple badges for their *budo* clothing.

The badges of honour of the Deutscher Dan-Traeger und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V.

There are two sets of badges of honour issued by the DDBV e.V., one for long-term members, one for extraordinary accomplishments fostering the statutory objectives of the DDBV e.V.

Abstrakt

Stowarzyszenie Deutscher Dan-Traeger und Budo-Lehrer Verband e.V. zostało założone w 1979 roku i używa dwóch różnych rodzajów znaczków z tkaniny dla Karate lub Jiu-Jitsu keikogi. Standardowa odznaka może być noszona przez wszystkich członków stowarzyszenia, natomiast odznaka "Budo Lehrer" (Nauczyciel Budo) jest zarezerwowana dla członków stowarzyszenia, którzy uzyskali certyfikat "DDBV Budo-Lehrer". Ponadto, istnieją przypinki honorowe, które są wydawane długoletnim członkom oraz za nadzwyczajne osiągnięcia wspierające cele statutowe stowarzyszenia.
